How to get to Cordoba

The nearest airports are in Madrid, Seville and Malaga. If you fly to Madrid we advise you to take taxi (25-30 euros) or underground (1 euro) from the **airport** to the train station (**Atocha RENFE**).

In case of Seville and Malaga we recommend you to take a taxi because the venue is not well served by public transport. Allow at least half an hour to get from the railway station to the airport in each of these cities.

Abstract submission

Participants are encouraged to submit an abstract in order to contribute actively to the workshop. Abstracts will be considered for poster or oral presentation by the scientific committee. Selection for oral presentation will be based on originality, style, content, methodology, and current relevance. Guidelines for poster and oral presentations will be sent to selected authors with notification of acceptance. All accepted abstracts will be printed in the book of abstracts that will be provided at the beginning of the workshop.

All abstracts must be submitted by email to anam.torres.romero@juntadeandalucia.es deadline **15 of June 2006**. Please name your file according to the following format: Fababean2006_surname of presenting author.doc (e.g. Fababean2006_Torres.doc) Presenting authors will be notified of their abstract's status (poster or oral presentation) by the end of July 2006.

Abstract style and content

Abstracts should be short, clear, concise and written in English with correct spelling and good sentence structure.

Each abstract should include:

- A short title
- The names and affiliations of authors
- A clear statement of the **background and objectives** of the study
- A brief statement of **materials and methods**, if pertinent
- A summary of the **results** obtained
- A statement about **conclusions**

Abstract format

When preparing your abstract, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- The abstract (including title, authors and their affiliations and references) must fit into a 16cm (wide) by 24cm (high) area and should not exceed 1000 words (2-3 pages).
- Use a WORD compatible software.
- Use 11-point Arial font.
- Use 1,5 line spacing.
- Type the title in bold, capital letters. Title should not exceed 100 characters and spaces.
- List author name(s) under the title (surname, followed by initials of first and middle names). The name of the presenting author should be underlined. Provide affiliation, full mailing address and email address of the first (or presenting) author and affiliation of co-authors.
- Use standard abbreviations for units of measure. Other abbreviations should be spelled out in full at first mention, followed by the abbreviation in parentheses (Exceptions: DNA, RNA, etc.).
- Set the text of abstract as flush left and right (justified). Do not indent paragraphs, and do not place hard returns at the end of each line.
- For tables, charts or figures one additional page will be accepted.
- Please proofread carefully for formatting, spelling and other types of errors.
